### Colour

Pale straw in colour with a persistent, fine bead.

#### Nose

The wine displays soft, rich fruit characters and freshness, combined with yeast aromas.

#### **Palate**

The palate is full and flavoursome, offering fresh fruit characters and a touch of sweetness effectively softening the finish. Showing excellent balance, the integrated fruit and yeast characters have contributed to the full, mouthfilling flavour and sof
