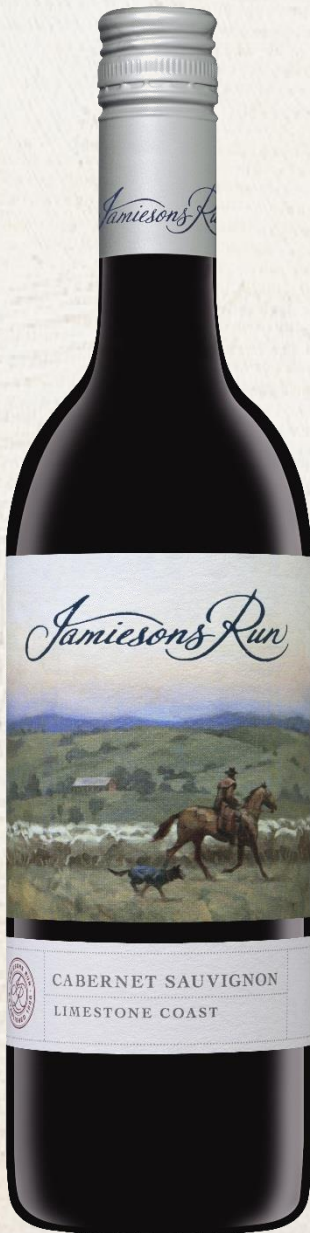

Jamiesons Run

Cabernet Sauvignon



The original Jamiesons Run was a remote outback sheep station owned in the mid 1800's by the pioneering Jamieson Brothers. Their heritage is celebrated by wines crafted from fruit grown in Limestone Coast and are a tribute to the regions past and future.

Since the 1950s the Limestone Coast has been producing outstanding wines with a winemaking focus that starts in the vineyards.

Winemaker Comments

Grape Variety: Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard Region: Limestone Coast, South Australia

Colour: Dark crimson red

Nose: Lifted fruit aromas of plum, black cherry, raspberry, with juicy blackcurrants: complimented by light cedar and allspice from the oak.

Palate: Medium bodied, soft and rounded with a generous array of ripe berry fruit flavours and a velvety long finish. The bright berry fruit aromas are reflected in the palate. This is a consistently good Cabernet sauvignon from an excellent vintage.

Maturation: This wine was matured in stainless steel tanks; some with a small proportion of French and American oak.
