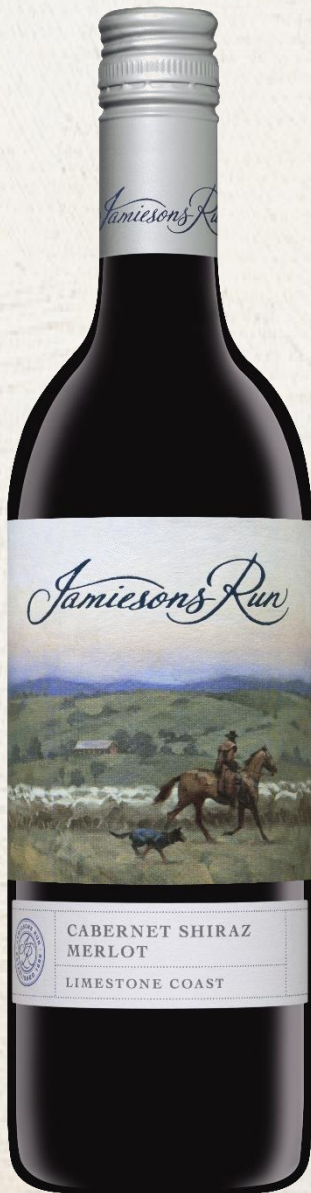


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# Jamiesons Run

## Limestone Coast Cabernet Shiraz Merlot



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The original Jamiesons Run was a remote outback sheep station owned by the Jamieson Brothers in the mid 1800s. The winery was named after the siblings as a tribute to the Limestone Coast's pioneering past.

Since the early 1950s Jamiesons Run has been crafting fruit with a winemaking focus that starts in the vineyard.

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### Winemaker Comments

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**Grape Variety:** Cabernet Shiraz Merlot

**Vineyard Region:** Limestone Coast, South Australia

**Colour:** Bright ruby red

**Nose:** Fragrant lifted aromas of dark plum, cherry and blackcurrant fruit. Layers of ripe dark fruits with a hint of mint and liquorice and some well-integrated, light, spicy oak.

**Palate:** Soft supple palate, a generous medium bodied wine with a fine texture and pleasing length of dark fruit flavours on the finish. Most evident is the dark fruits of plums, fresh ripe cherry, blackberry and juicy mulberry supported by cedary oak. Fine slightly chalky tannins, add to the texture and balanced finish.

**Maturation:** This wine was matured with Hungarian, French and American oak to add depth and complexity.

**Cellaring potential:** This wine is made to drink now.
