



## Brut de Brut Non Vintage

Seaview's strength is directly related to its ability to source premium quality grapes from a multitude of vineyards in some of the country's best wine regions, to achieve a consistency of style. Many of these vineyards specialise in the traditional Champagne grape varieties and are located in cool climate areas, with the Pinot Noir component making a major contribution to the Seaview Brut de Brut style.

Seaview Brut de Brut is the drier version of sparkling wine Seaview Brut. Here Brut de Brut indicates that the wine is extra Brut or very dry.
